Biographical History

Shuichi Nagata became interested in the Hopi village of Moenkopi in the summer of 1960, while he was there on an archaeological field trip. In 1962, while working as a research associate with the University of Illinois, Professor Julian Steward encouraged Nagata to pursue the topic of Hopi modernization. From 1962 to 1965, he spent many months working in the field with the people of Moenkopi. He spent most of 1965 writing a dissertation based on his research.

Scope and Content

Collection consists of compiled research notes from Keams Canyon Agency letter books (dated 1880-1916) and research material from residents of Moenkopi in anticipation of Nagata's PhD thesis, which was completed in 1966. Also included is material from a presentation Nagata gave in 1978 on Hopi Status systems, as well as an expanded version that was to be published.

Conditions Governing Access
