Biographical History

Edna Hope Gregory was the wife of Dr. Herbert E. Gregory of the US Geological Survey, and at one time director of the Bernice E. Bishop Museum in Honolulu. Dr. Gregory spent many years in the Colorado Plateau country, as his many USGS publications attest: *Geology of the Navajo Country*, *Water Supply of Navajo Country*, *The San Juan Country*, *The Kaiparowits Region of Utah and Arizona*, *The Geology and Geography of the Zion Park Region*, etc. Mrs. Gregory accompanied her husband on many field trips, and kept diaries of some of her trips.

Scope and Content

Collection contains 6 of Edna Hope Gregory's diaries from the years between 1908 and 1936, and excerpts from correspondence written by Herbert E. Gregory to his wife from roughly the same period. Also included is an article written by Edna on Kanaka Ranch (aka. Iosepa), a settlement of Mormon Hawaiians in Utah. The article *Iosepa, Hawaiian Experiment in Utah* was published in *Paradise of the Pacific* in 1947. Gregory's notes and correspondence regarding the publication are also present. Lastly, the collection contains six photographs and a map of Orderville Utah, a settlement which was a Mormon experiment at communal living.
