Biographical History

Albert J. Levine (12 June 1914-1 August 1981) was born in New York. He moved to Arizona and became a cattle rancher near Snowflake, where he married his wife, Louise. Levine was very interested in the history of the Snowflake area, and published two books on the subject: Snowflake: A pictorial review, 1878-1964 in 1964 and From Indian trails to jet trails: Snowflake's centennial history in 1977.

Between 1975 and 1979, Levine conducted a photographic survey of the rock art (petroglyphs and pictographs) in Silver Creek Canyon, which runs between Snowflake and the Little Colorado River. Silver Creek rises south of Showlow and flows nearly straight north to its junction with the Little Colorado River, south of Woodruff.

Levine passed away in Snowflake at the age of 67.

Scope and Content

This collection consists of an unpublished manuscript entitled "The Rock Art of Silver Creek Canyon, Snowflake, Arizona" consisting of photographic materials, maps, charts, and diagrams. The manuscript arrived in 2 loose-bound volumes, which have been re-housed in folders with original sections preserved.
