Biographical History

Carl Lampland was an astronomer who began work at Lowell Observatory in 1902. He designed cameras and telescopes for planetary observation and worked closely with Percival Lowell on photographic exploration of Mars and Pluto.

Scope and Content

Collection consists of 41 photographic travel images from across Northern Arizona (Tanner Crossing, Echo Cliffs, Lee's Ferry, the Grand Canyon, construction of the Hoover Dam).

Immediate Source of Acquisition

The bulk of the collection was donated by Mrs. Carl O. Lampland in the 1950s. A subsequent addition was made in 1966.
