Biographical History

Archaeologist Roger Kelly was with the Museum of Northern Arizona from 1963 to 1967. He began as a Follow in Archaeology under the direction of Curator of Anthropology Alan P. Olson. In 1965, he became a Museum Fellow. From 1965 to 1967, he held the position of Archaeologist, MNA and NAU. During his tenure at MNA, he was directly responsible for a number of the museum's salvage archaeology projects.

Scope and Content

Collection consists of Kelly's unpublished report from his work near Cornfields and Wide Ruins in northeastern Arizona, the culmination of work done an MNA project A-63-3. Also included are reviews of the report in anticipation of its eventual publication.
