### Biographical History

Mrs. Rose Weisberg worked for the BIA [Bureau of Indian Affairs] Rock Point School on the Navajo Reservation in Chinle, Arizona in 1971.

### Scope and Content

Collection includes a handwritten letter to Edward B. Danson concerning Navajo medicine bundles she sold to the museum and an article that was being written about them (Wyman, 1972). The letter also describes a "Navajo witching doll" that Weisberg was interested in selling to the museum. The collection also includes Danson's response to Weisberg about Leland Wyman's article on medicine bundles and his interest in the witching doll.
