Biographical History

In the school year of 1974-1975, Jan C. Green was a graduate student of anthropology at Northern Arizona University. She wrote two reports based on the oral history of Florence G. Turner for ANTH 419 Museum Technique and ANTH 665 Research Methods.

Scope and Content

The collection consists of 2 reports based on oral history cassettes narrated by Florence G. Turner, who worked for C.N. Cotton, a trader of Navajo rugs in Gallup, New Mexico. The reports are entitled, "C.N. Cotton and Navajo "Rugs" with Taped Remembrances by Florence G. Turner" and "Using Oral History: Building from the Memories of Florence G. Turner."
