### **Biographical History**

William H. Carroll (January 1856-26 October 1926) was born in New York to Irish-born parents. He was married to Mary E. Carroll, and was a pioneer resident of Flagstaff. The Carrolls ran the Carrollton Hotel on San Francisco Street in the early 1900s.

### **Scope and Content**

The collection contains photographic material documenting early Arizona history, and especially the early history of Flagstaff. Collection also contain early images of the Grand Canyon.
