Biographical History

Donald M. Hall was a professional author and photographer. His focus was on the Western United States, and the Colorado Plateau more specifically. He accumulated a large collection of 35mm transparencies of the Plateau, the earliest dating back to the 1950s.

Scope and Content

Collection consists of copies of 1400 35mm transparency slides (nearly all Kodachrome) of images from around the Colorado Plateau. Locations include **Utah** (Capitol Reef, Boulder Mountain, Escalante, Grosvenor Arch, Johnson Canyon, Old Paria, Hells Backbone, Mexican Hat, Natural Bridges, Abajo Mountains, Arches National Park), **Arizona** (Lake Powell, Wupatki National Monument, Grand Canyon, Oak Creek Canyon, Schnebly Hill Road, Sedona, San Francisco Peaks, Black Mesa, Kayenta, Monument Valley, Painted Desert, Navajo National Monument, Canyon de Chelly), **Colorado** (Cortez, Animas Valley, Durango, Pagosa Springs, Colorado National Monument, Unaweep Canyon, Dolores River Canyon, Paradox Valley), and **New Mexico** (Angel Peak, Shiprock), in addition to other sites in the region.
