Native Art Market 2018

We cordially invite you to join us for the 3rd Annual Native Art Market in honor of Native American Heritage Month on **Saturday, December 1, 2018 from 10 am to 5 pm.**

- **A Members Preview will be held Saturday, December 1, 2018 from 9 am to 10 am.**
- Artists are welcome to apply for one of 25 available booth spaces.
- Each booth space includes one six-foot table and two chairs.
- All displayed artwork must be for sale and approved for inclusion.
- MNA encourages artists to offer a wide variety of price points.
- Commercially-made items – t-shirts, mugs, printed items – are not permissible unless they are your own design.
- Refund Policy: If the withdrawal is made 60 days or more prior to the first day of the event, the vendor will receive a 50% refund on the booth fee; if it is made 59 days or less from the first day of the event, no refunds are available as all funds are committed to event production, promotion, and marketing. All refund requests must be made in writing and received by our office via email or mail. Please site reason for withdrawal.

Please Note

Effective January 2017, the State of Arizona took over the administration and collection of all Transaction Privilege Tax (TPT) for all Arizona cities. All vendors wishing to do business in Arizona must now apply through the state to obtain a state TPT license, one for each municipality it wishes to do business in.

To help offset the cost of licensing with the state, MNA has lowered booth fees for its 2018 festivals and the museum is also no longer required to collect the City of Flagstaff \$15 Special Event TPT fee from each artist as it has in previous years.

We have been told it can take several weeks for the state to process an application, so we encourage you to apply well in advance of your festival if you do not already have a state issued TPT license which includes the city of Flagstaff. Your TPT application must be filed with the State of Arizona, **not** sent back to MNA with your festival application.

Both the state and the City of Flagstaff have the right to audit an event to check for proper licensing of vendors, so we encourage you to have your license with you at your booth during the festival weekend.

- Artist's statement and/or biography
- Signed photo release (see page 2)
- Three photos per medium of your most recent work (electronic images accepted)
- Stamped and self-addressed envelope if you would like your images returned
- Copy of your tribal enrollment card or a copy of a letter from your tribe or agency on official letterhead and signed by a senior tribal official or enrollment specialist, clearly verifying your enrollment (per 1990 Indian Arts and Crafts Act).
- Payment for booth fee including:**
 - Booth Payment fee \$50 per booth
 - \$25 nonrefundable application fee per artist
