

Background

The Sedona Muses of the Museum of Northern Arizona was founded in 1983 as an auxiliary organization. As such, The Muses provide educational opportunities to Sedona and Verde Valley residents and visitors that focus on the art, anthropology, archaeology, paleontology, geology, biology, ecology and cultural resources of the Colorado Plateau.
