Native American Artists from the Colorado Plateau region are invited to apply for a vendor/ booth space for one of these four weekends including: July 2nd- 4th, July 9th- 11th, July 16th- 18th, and July 23rd- 25th

#### **Important Updates:**

MNA is taking precautions to make this event safe and prevent the spread of Covid-19 in the community. This includes monitoring the case levels and waiting until near the event to making a final decision on whether it is safe to proceed. We will make a decision on this event by **May 31**st, **2021**. We will then begin collecting booth and application fees at this time.

We will not be collecting fees until May 31<sup>st</sup>. All artists/vendors will be required to pay all booth and application fees before or during artist check in. **Full payment is due before or upon arrival**.

#### Other Important Updates:

To help prevent the spread of Covid-19, we will be transitioning into using outdoor venues, this includes moving artist booth spaces outside of the exhibit building. Please contact Public Programs staff if you require special accommodations.

There will not be a juried competition for the 2021 festival season.

All vendors wishing to do business in Arizona must apply through the state to obtain a state TPT license. We have been told it can take several weeks for the state to process an application, so we encourage you to apply well in advance of the event if you do not already have a state issued TPT license which includes the city of Flagstaff. Your TPT application must be filed with the State of Arizona, not sent back to MNA with your festival application. Both the state and the City of Flagstaff have the right to audit an event to check for proper licensing of vendors, so we encourage you to have your license with you at your booth during the festival weekend.

#### **Booth Information**

- <u>Each</u> artist must submit a completed application. Each artist is responsible for applying for their own Arizona TPT License (please see included letter for more information). Children 17 and under do not pay fees but need to fill out an application for MNA records.
- Artists may only apply for one of 35 booth spaces available each week. Each artist may only apply to sell for one
  weekend and must indicate preference below.
- Booth Spaces
  - This year MNA will NOT providing tables or chairs for artists. All artist vendors are to provide their own tables and chairs.
  - Artists may need to provide their own canopy / E-Z UP for an outside vendor space, Public Programs staff will email information to artists with an outside booth.
  - 10x10 Booth spaces will be assigned on a first-come, first-served basis. Booth assignments subject to availability.
  - All displayed artwork must be for sale and approved for inclusion.
  - Oversized displays or racks may be charged an additional fee. Please call the Public Programs office for details.
- Exhibitor booths will open from 10 am to 5 pm each day of the festival weekend, each artist is encouraged
  to be ready to sell at least 15 minutes before the start of each day of the festival.
- Shared Booths
  - You may share your booth with only <u>one</u> other selling artist.
  - If sharing a booth, indicate on your application who you are sharing with and how fees are being split/shared.
  - Each artist in a shared booth is responsible for submitting their own application and applying for their own Arizona TPT License.
- Masks are mandatory on MNA campus for artists, staff, and visitors.
- Please keep your booth space clean and organized. It is your responsibility to provide hand sanitizer and appropriate cleaning supplies for your booth throughout the market weekend.

#### **General Festival Information**

- All applications will be held to standards and regulations established by the Indian Arts and Crafts Board.
- All displayed artwork must be for sale and approved for inclusion.
- MNA encourages artists to offer a wide variety of price points.
