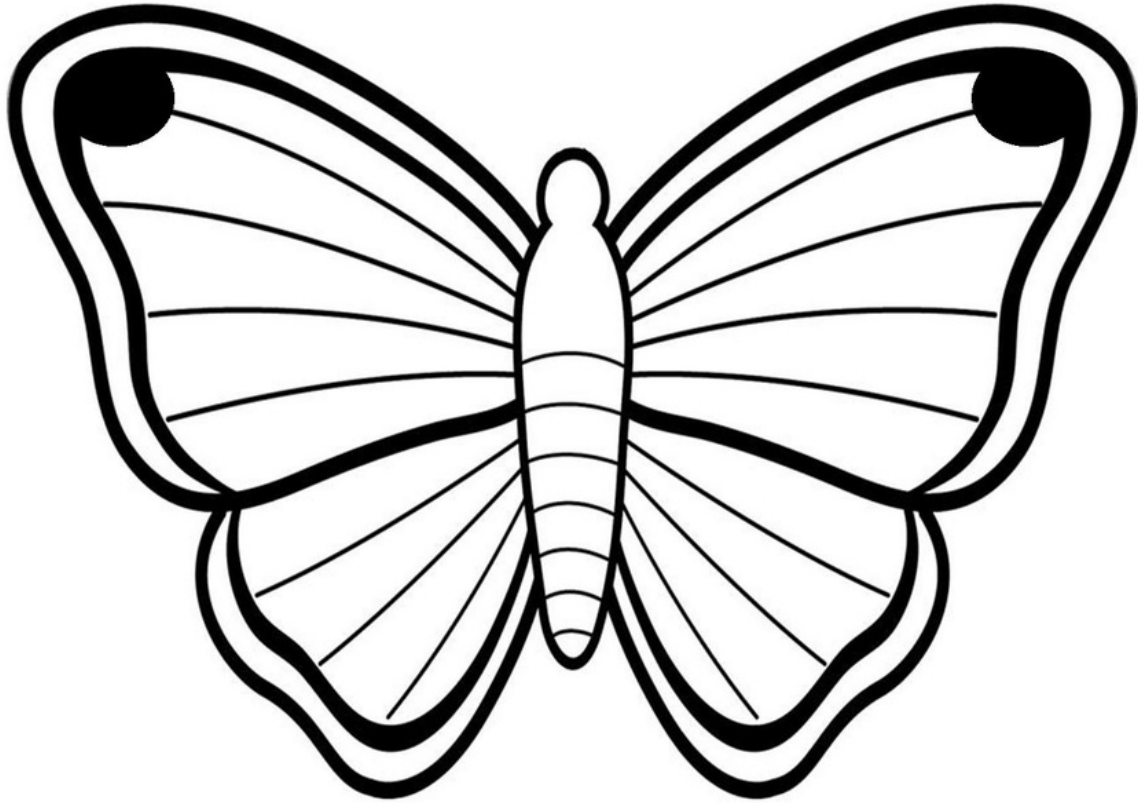


Balancing Butterfly



Print this butterfly on heavy paper then color it and cut it out. Place the head of the butterfly on the tip of your finger. Does it balance or does it fall? Put paper clips in the front corner of each wing, where the black dots are. Try to balance the butterfly again.

What's happening – By adding weights you have changed the butterfly's center of gravity, or balance point. Experiment with moving the paperclips around.
