

Welcome Festival Artists!

It is time to plan for the **2022 Heritage Festival of Arts & Culture** at the Museum of Northern Arizona (MNA). This year's festival will be held July 1-3, 2022 and will be a celebration of ALL tribal communities on the Colorado Plateau.

Why one festival for all Native People of the Colorado Plateau?

Holding a single festival allows us to be more inclusive. The culture-specific festivals MNA used to hold for the Hopi, Navajo, and Zuni, but left out many other Native people of the region, such as the Pai people. The culture specific festivals also created difficulties for the many people who are of mixed Native heritage.

Important Updates:

- The 2022 Heritage Festival will be held outside.
- NO BOOTHS WILL BE HOUSED INSIDE THE MUSEUM EXHIBIT SPACE.
- The 2022 Heritage Festival will be a juried show. All artist applications will be reviewed by a jury committee. Artists will be notified of acceptance by April 29, 2022.
- All applications need to be submitted with a non-refundable \$25 application fee. No applications will be considered without this payment.
- ALL APPLICATIONS ARE DUE BY MARCH 31, 2022
 - o Incomplete applications will not be considered
 - Applications without the \$25 application fee will not be considered
 - All applications must be submitted with the following materials

Application Checklist

- Fully completed application
- Artist's statement or bio
- Copy of your tribal enrollment card
- Two images for each classification indicated
- Signed acknowledgment (see bottom of page 4)

Booth Information

- <u>Each</u> artist must submit a completed application. Each artist is responsible for paying a \$25 application fee. Children 16 and under do not pay fees but need to fill out an application for MNA records. <u>The \$25</u> application fee is due with each application.
- Booth Spaces
 - Booth spaces will be located throughout MNA campus, which includes the exhibit building parking lot and the research campus across the street on Fort Valley.
 - o Artists can apply for one of two types of booth spaces:
 - 1. Pre-Prepared Booth Space (LIMITED)
 - a. Underneath prepared tent in a 10x10 space
 - b. Comes with one 6-foot table and 2 chairs

2. Self-Set-Up Booth Space

- a. Uncovered 10x10 space, artists must provide their own tent
- b. Artists must provide their own table and chairs
- Booths will be assigned on a first-apply, first-served basis. Booth assignments subject to availability.
- o There will be no access to power or electricity for majority of artist booths.

Shared Booths

- You may share your booth with only <u>one</u> other selling artist.
- If sharing a booth, you must indicate on your application who you are sharing with and how fees are being split/shared.
- Each artist in a shared booth is responsible for submitting their own application and applying for their own Arizona TPT License.
- A full refund (minus the application fee) is available only if cancelation is submitted in writing 30 days prior to the festival (June 1). No refunds will be issued for cancelations made after 29 days or closer to the festival date.

Awards

• The juried competition is open only to artists accepted into the festival. Each artist may submit up to three items into the competition. More than \$8,000 in prize money and ribbons will be awarded at the festival.

All applications must be complete and submitted with required materials. ALL INCOMPLETE APPLICATIONS WILL NOT BE CONSIDERED.

Applications can be submitted via mail, or in-person.
