- Help to improve facilities services and proactively identify and resolve potential safety issues.
- Help to organize and maintain the facilities shop and adjacent storage areas, including equipment and tools in the buildings while maintaining equipment and vehicles in good working order.
- Performs occasional custodial duties as needed.
- Other duties as assigned.

**Education / Experience and Other Requirements:**

- High school diploma or equivalent.
- Experience in construction trades and/or maintenance of buildings and grounds.
- Use of basic hand tools including carpentry, plumbing and general maintenance tools.
- Must have a reliable vehicle and valid AZ driver's license and insurance.
- Must be able to pass a standard background check.

- Enjoy physical indoor and outdoor work.
