2024 Winter Market will be held from **Saturday**, **December 7**th **– Sunday**, **December 8**th at the Museum of Northern Arizona, inside the Branigar/Chase Auditorium and the Living Room. Colorado Plateau Indigenous artists are invited to apply for one of 25 available booth spaces, each measuring 5x10 feet.

Booth set up is on Friday, December 6th. Please do not apply if:

- You cannot be there to set up your booth on Friday.
- You cannot be at the Members' Preview (Saturday 8:30 10:00 am).
- You cannot stay the entire weekend.


All artists must be able to set up on Friday, attend the Members' Preview, and stay through the weekend.

Payment for booth fee: \$25 nonrefundable application fee per artist

Booth Information (This is an indoor market)

- All artists are to provide their own tables or rent one from MNA for \$10.
- 5x10 booth spaces will be assigned on a first-apply, first-served basis.
- All displayed artwork must be for sale and approved for inclusion.
- Booths must be open from 8:30 to 4:00 on Saturday, December 7th and from 10:00 to 4:00 on Sunday, December 8th. The Members' Preview event is a benefit to MNA's members and a great opportunity to sell your work.
- Shared Booths
 - You may share your booth with only <u>one</u> other selling artist.
 - o If sharing a booth, include the name of the artist you are sharing with on your application.
 - Each artist in a shared booth is responsible for submitting their own application and applying for their own Arizona TPT License.
